1. **Call to Order:** Chair Palla called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m. noting all subcommittee members were present with the exception of Vice Mayor Wolter.
2. **Communications:** None
3. **Public Comment:** Rich Cowart, Cloverdale, stated his appreciation for the help received in changing the regimen of a student whom he tutors and his belief that these changes will help this student a lot. Chair Palla suggested creating a program to enable high school students to earn their community service credit by tutoring students in lower grades with special needs.
4. **Approval of Minutes:** The minutes for July 20, 2015, and October 26, 2015, were approved.
5. **Current Items for Discussion:**
 - a. Introduction of the CHS Principal, Kirsten Sanft: Carried over to next meeting.
 - b. Tennis Court Seating - information item: Superintendent Decker stated they are looking to put bleacher seating on both ends of the tennis courts, starting with the baseball side, to be funded by the boosters. Chair Palla suggested the City, School District, and Cloverdale Tennis Association recognize the Eagle Pride Booster Club when the project is completed.
 - c. Cloverdale High School Seniors Local History Projects (Wolter): Carried over to next meeting.
 - d. Update - CAPE Program: Chair Palla stated he met with Supervisor Gore and let him know Cloverdale would like the CAPE program to be continued after the current three-year period. Chair Palla stated the expiration date of the current funding is needed, as well as feedback regarding what the program has accomplished, for inclusion in a paper to submit to Supervisor Gore for his presentation to the Board of Supervisors. Superintendent Decker stated his belief that the current school year is year two of the three-year period and that he will need Chair Palla's help regarding how the program came about.
 - e. Update - After school transportation to Boys & Girls Club: Discussion regarding this item included recent changes to the local bus route, which gives the children another option to get to the Boys & Girls Club, as well as the two school buses and van which the school district is operating.
 - f. Discussion – Lights for intersection at Cloverdale Blvd and School Street: Chief Cramer discussed the street light auditing program the night crew of the police department is conducting every two weeks and that PG&E puts a priority on repairing street lights near schools. Discussion ensued regarding lighting for the crosswalk at the high school, including that completion of the South Cloverdale Boulevard crosswalk lighting project needs to occur first to ensure this will work for the school crosswalk.
 - g. 2016 Citrus Fair - Feb 12th - 14th – Booth: Discussion of the theme of public safety for the City's booth at the Citrus Fair was conducted.

He learned that 4Cs in Healdsburg lost their building, reached out to them, found the empty buildings by the JEH will work, and the District will have 32 new slots for preschool next year.

Chief Cramer stated he found the Cloverdale High School Key Club induction ceremony he attended to be very special and he enjoyed it.

Superintendent Decker stated the district's website is being updated, the teachers are having their webpages built, and they have changed the way it looks and invited everyone to check it out.
