1. **Call to Order:** Chair Palla called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m. noting all subcommittee members were present.

4. **Approval of Minutes:** The minutes for January 25, 2016, were approved.
5. **Current Items for Discussion:**
  - a. Introduction of the CHS Principal, Kirsten Sanft: Subcommittee members and Ms. Sanft introduced themselves to one another. Ms. Sanft then shared a brief overview of her career.
  - b. Cloverdale High School Seniors Local History Projects: Mr. Cayler presented this item and conversation ensued regarding what is currently being done along these lines and possibilities in the future with the video production space that will be under construction during the next school year. Chair Palla requested an update on this item at the next meeting from Ms. Sanft.
  - c. Pedestrian safety crosswalk lights, Cloverdale Blvd & School Street intersection: Mr. Cayler presented this item, stating he hopes to put budgeting in for next year for a similar system to what is going in at the crosswalk at Treadway and S. Cloverdale Blvd. Chair Palla requested Mr. Cayler come up with an amount to have an outside contractor install the lights.  
Mr. Cayler requested item 5f to be moved up in the agenda.
  - f. Student liaison: Discussion regarding the current student liaison and the recruitment of a new student liaison for the next school year was conducted.
  - d. CAPE Program: Chair Palla stated he needs some statistics of how CAPE was brought in, how they helped, and how important it is to continue the program to present to Rep. James Gore when they meet April 6.
  - e. LCAP update: Continued to next meeting, as a projector is needed for the 30-45 minute presentation.
  - g. Thyme Square conceptual designs: Mr. Cayler presented this item and invited feedback. Mr. Decker stated he liked the Police Department being housed next to the skate park. Discussion about how the facility will be managed ensued.
