A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLOVERDALE AMENDING THE 2018-19 BUDGET TO INCORPORATE THE INSTALLATION OF A PEDESTRIAN AUDIO CROSSWALK SIGNAL AT S. CLOVERDALE BLVD. AND BROOKSIDE DRIVE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$15,000

WHEREAS, a vision-impaired resident of the City of Cloverdale requested a pedestrian audio crosswalk signal at the intersection of S. Cloverdale Blvd. and Brookside Dr.; and

WHEREAS, The City of Cloverdale is obligated to provide a pedestrian audio crosswalk signal at the requested intersection as per Revision 3 (Rev 3), to the 2014 California Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (CA MUTCD), Chapter 4E Pedestrian Control Features, Section 4E.09 Accessible Pedestrian Signals and Detectors, Pp. 947-949.; and

WHEREAS, DC Electric provides traffic signal maintenance to the City of Cloverdale; and

WHEREAS, DC Electric provided a quotation to install a pedestrian audio signal at the subject intersection; and

WHEREAS, there is no fiscal impact, as revenues in the Gas Tax Fund, Street Light LED Conversion will offset any expenditures in the added Pedestrian Audio Crosswalk Signal Installation budget.

NOW, THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, ORDERED AND FOUND by the City Council of the City of Cloverdale, State of California, that the City of Cloverdale, Fiscal Year 2018-19, Budget will be amended as follows:

1. The Amend the FY 18/19 Budget to include \$15,000 in a new line item "Pedestrian Audio Crosswalk Signal Installation" (210-40-402-42218-000).
2. The Amend the FY 18/19 Budget line item "Street Light LED conversion" (210-40-402-42218-000) will be decreased by \$15,000.



- Program new PPB stations and confirm proper operation.

All other material is stock with DC Electric Group, Inc. and work can be completed within five (5) working days from receipt of new APS material and Notice to Proceed from the City of Cloverdale.
