**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLOVERDALE  
AUTHORIZING APPLICATION TO THE METROPOLITAN TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION FOR EXEMPTION FROM  
THE LOCAL BICYCLE ADVISORY COMMITTEE (BAC)/ BICYCLE AND PEDESTRIAN ADVISORY COMMITTEE (BPAC)  
REQUIREMENT AND DESIGNATING THE SCTA COUNTYWIDE BICYCLE AND PEDESTRIAN ADVISORY COMMITTEE  
(SCTA CBPAC) AS THE REVIEW BODY FOR TRANSPORTATION DEVELOPMENT ACT ARTICLE 3 PEDESTRIAN AND  
BICYCLE FUNDING IN THE CITY OF CLOVERDALE.**

**WHEREAS**, the Metropolitan Transportation Commission (MTC) is responsible for establishing policies and procedures for Transportation Development Act Article 3 Pedestrian and Bicycle (TDA 3) grant funding; and

**WHEREAS**, in June 2013, the MTC updated TDA 3 policies by adopting Resolution 4108 which requires each jurisdiction to have a local Bicycle Advisory Committee (BAC)/Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Committee (BPAC) to review and prioritize TDA Article 3 bicycle and pedestrian projects and to participate in the development and review of comprehensive bicycle plans; and

**WHEREAS**, MTC guidance allows a local agency to apply for an exemption from using a local BAC/BPAC if it can demonstrate that the countywide BAC/BPAC provides for expanded city representation; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of Cloverdale has appointed a representative on the Sonoma County Transportation Authority (SCTA) Countywide Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Committee (CBPAC); and

**WHEREAS**, said representation on the SCTA CBPAC provides for expanded city representation.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF CLOVERDALE AS FOLLOWS:**

1. The SCTA CBPAC provides for expanded city representation in the City of Cloverdale.
2. The City of Cloverdale hereby directs the City Manager or designee to apply to MTC for exemption from the city BAC/BPAC requirement.
3. The City of Cloverdale hereby identifies the SCTA CBPAC as the review body for Transportation Development Act Article 3 Funding of pedestrian and bicycle projects in the City of Cloverdale.
4. The City of Cloverdale hereby identifies the Mayor of Cloverdale or their designated representative from the Planning Department as the City of Cloverdale representative on said committee.
