RESOLUTION NO. 61 –2019

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLOVERDALE APPROVING A NEW MASTER PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH COASTLAND CIVIL ENGINEERING, INC. FOR FEMA PROJECT SUPPORT AND GENERAL ENGINEERING SUPPORT FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$50,000 AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY

WHEREAS, the Public Works and Engineering Departments currently work with Coastland Civil Engineering, Inc. to provide development review for various projects throughout the City of Cloverdale; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works and Engineering Departments have relied on Coastland Civil Engineering, Inc. to provide municipal engineering support; and

WHEREAS, the new FEMA-funded projects include FEMA Category B: Emergency Protective Measures projects that Coastland Civil Engineering, Inc. is qualified to provide; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer anticipates additional general engineering assistance (task orders) will be required for which Coastland Civil Engineering, Inc. is also qualified to provide.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Cloverdale hereby approves a new master professional services agreement (Master PSA) with Coastland Civil Engineering, Inc. to provide FEMA Category B project support and general engineering assistance for an amount not to exceed \$50,000 and authorizing the City Manager to execute the agreement on behalf of the City.
