RESOLUTION NO. 113–2019**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLOVERDALE ESTABLISHING THE INTERSECTION  
OF N. CLOVERDALE BLVD AND NORTH STREET AS A CONTROLLED INTERSECTION WITH A 3-WAY STOP  
SIGN**

**WHEREAS**, the intersection of North Cloverdale Blvd and North Street is used as main crossing location for school children going to Jefferson Elementary School; and

**WHEREAS**, During the school year, a crossing guard is posted at this location during times when school children are present; and

**WHEREAS**, the Public Works Subcommittee, at the regularly scheduled meeting of September 24, 2019, supported the request for a 3-way stop; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Engineer has reviewed the North Cloverdale Blvd. and North Street. intersection configuration and safety concerns pursuant to Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways, California Edition, 2014, Revision 3, Chapter 2B, Section 2B.04 and found that further traffic control devices are not warranted at this time; and

**WHEREAS**, the Chief of Police has reviewed the intersection of North Cloverdale Blvd. St. and North Street and has determined that a traffic control measures would assist with traffic management; and

**WHEREAS**, Cloverdale Municipal Code Section 10.12.010(C) grants City Engineer conditional authority to “place and maintain or cause to be placed and maintained such additional traffic-control devices as he may deem necessary or proper to regulate traffic or to guide or warn traffic”; and

**WHEREAS**, the Public Works Subcommittee, at their September 24, 2019 meeting supported the Police Chief’s request to convert the intersection to a 3-way stop, expressed concern regarding the time necessary to perform a traffic study and directed staff bring forward a resolution to City Council for consideration; and

**WHEREAS**, as the City Council has reviewed and considered the recommendation of the Public Works Subcommittee.

**NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLOVERDALE FINDS AND RESOLVES AS  
FOLLOWS:**

1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct.
2. City Council, for the purpose of expediency, waives preparation of a traffic study prior to conversion of the intersection to a 3-way stop.
3. Authorize the Public Works Department to proceed with conversion of the intersection of North Cloverdale Blvd. and North Street to a 3-way stop intersection.


