



Virtual Community Workshop on Local Hazard Mitigation Plan and General Plan Public Health and Safety Element

June 2, 2021: 5:00 to 7:00 p.m.

On Wednesday, June 2, 2021 the City of Cloverdale will be hosting a Virtual Community Workshop to present the recently completed Public Review Drafts of the City's Local Hazard Mitigation Plan and General Plan Public Health and Safety Element. Together, the two plans identify ways that the City can protect residents, workers, and visitors from the harmful effects of natural hazards. The workshop will provide an opportunity for Cloverdale residents and others who are interested to ask questions and provide comments about the plans and the planning process. It is part of larger public review and comment process that will run through the summer before the plans are adopted in the fall.
