




## Local Hazard Mitigation Plan and General Plan Public Health and Safety Element - Public Review Draft

To identify ways that the City can protect residents, workers, and visitors from the harmful effects of natural hazards, the City has completed a Public Review Draft Local Hazard Mitigation Plan (LHMP) and a Public Review Draft update of its General Plan Public Health and Safety Element (Safety Element). The Safety Element consists of two documents: Chapter 8 of the General Plan and Chapter 10 of the General Plan Background Report. The dual effort addresses associated Federal and State requirements to identify risks and vulnerabilities associated with natural disasters and to develop long-term strategies for protecting people and property from future hazard events. Federal law mandates that all state, tribal, and local governments prepare hazard mitigation plans in order to maintain eligibility for certain funding programs. State law encourages local governments to cross-link their hazard mitigation plans with their general plans, in part to maintain funding eligibility for State funding programs. The City of Cloverdale decided to address these State and Federal requirements simultaneously with a joint LHMP/Safety Element process.

The public review and comment period for the documents will last through the summer in conjunction with required review by the California Office of Emergency Services (Cal OES) and the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA). The City will also be hosting a series of meetings and workshops starting at the beginning of June. This will include an informational presentation to the Planning Commission on June 1, 2021, a Virtual Community Workshop on June 2, 2021 (from 5:00 to 7:00 p.m.), and a City Council presentation on June 9, 2021. Later in the summer, the City will commence with formal public hearings before the Commission and Council, leading to adoption of the LHMP and Safety Element in the fall.
