A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLOVERDALE ADOPTING THE CITY OF CLOVERDALE CURRENT SALARY SCHEDULE EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2021

WHEREAS, the California Public Employees' Retirement Law, at Section 570.5 of the California Code of Regulations Title 2, requires the City of Cloverdale to publish the City's Current Salary Schedule on the City's internet site and the City Council to approve the Salary Schedule in its entirety each time a modification is made; and

WHEREAS, on June 24, 2021, the City Council approved revised salary ranges pursuant to Resolution No. 065-2020; and

WHEREAS, On June 23, 2021, the City Council approved Resolution 060-2021 approving establishing a new salary schedule for the City Manager and approving a third amendment to the at-will agreement to the City Manager's employment agreement effective July 1st, 2021; and


WHEREAS, The Public Works Director/City Engineer salary schedule was updated as part of the recruitment to fill the vacant position; and
