RESOLUTION NO. 071 –2021

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLOVERDALE
REVISING THE CURRENT EMERGENCY OPERATIONS PLAN TO REFLECT THE
UPDATED SONOMA COUNTY PUBLIC SAFETY POWER SHUTOFF (PSPS)
ANNEX AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE SAID PLAN**

WHEREAS, the City of Cloverdale’s Emergency Operations Plan (EOP) is designed to identify the City’s emergency planning, organization, policies, procedures, and response to extraordinary emergencies associated with natural disasters, technological incidents, and national security emergencies; and

WHEREAS, the emergency plan establishes the emergency management organization required to mitigate any significant emergency or disaster affecting the City of Cloverdale, identifies the responsibilities, policies, and procedures required to protect the health and safety of the City of Cloverdale population, public and private property, and the environmental effects of natural and technological emergencies and disasters, and establishes the operational concepts and procedures associated with field response to emergencies, and City Emergency Operations Center (EOC) activities; and;

WHEREAS, the current Emergency Operations Plan was adapted by City Council on March 10, 2021 however, the Sonoma County Department of Emergency Management’s revision to the Sonoma County Public Safety Power Shutoff (PSPS) Annex is not reflected in the current plan; and

WHEREAS, the Public Safety Power Shutoff (PSPS) Annex is a critical component to the Emergency Operations Plan as it outlines procedures that guide a collaborative response to the threat of de-energization of electrical systems due to extreme fire danger; and

WHEREAS, Pacific Gas & Electric may shut down electricity transmission and distribution lines to portions of Sonoma County, including Cloverdale, during periods of heightened wildfire risk in order to minimize the potential for accidental fire ignitions; and

WHEREAS, the loss of electricity may directly threaten public health and impact public safety capabilities and communications systems; and

WHEREAS, the Annex serves as a planning document to support further development of major incident plans with city departments and agencies, and provides an overview of the threats these emergencies pose to the city; and

WHEREAS, On July 20th, 2021 the Sonoma County Board of Supervisors adopted the Public Safety Power Shutoff Annex to the Sonoma County Operational Area Emergency Operations Plan; and


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Cloverdale hereby adopts the County of Sonoma Public Safety Power Shutoff Annex to the City of Cloverdale Emergency Operations Plan and authorizes the City Manager to execute said plan on behalf of the City.
